Equipment Manager/Football: **Gary Sopoliga** Old cart is being repaired for \$350. Equipment pick up went very well. Only 25 late shows on Monday. The purchases that were approved last month were not purchased

yet. Shon Roarty said there was a lack of Varsity coaches at equipment pick up. Also the approved 25 new helmets were not purchased yet.

Equipment Manager/Cheer-Pom: Teresa Filban The uniforms will be delivered at practice next week. They will not give the girls their skirts, if the parents have not signed up to volunteer. Uniforms to be ~~delivered~~ **distributed** by color. FYI Some of the shells had to be returned to **MBS embelisher**, they had some marks on them. They are supposed to get the marks out and return within the week. Cost of one shell is \$80. Need to E-mail all Blue and Gold girls **that dropped** to see if they want SL Panthers to buy them **back** from them. Panthers will only buy back new unused shells. Patches for Cheer-Pom will go for each girl, unit director and coaches. Need to strongly encourage the girls to put the patch on the shells. Pom Cheer needs 4 boom boxes for the Pom squads. Lisa made the motion to purchase new boom boxes not exceeding \$400. The motion was seconded by Paul. Motion passed.

Treasurer: Paul Harper We paid the two high Schools their donations of \$3000 each. We have \$51,000 in savings and \$58,000 in the checking account. We give out 6 scholarships yearly. One parent of a scholarship recipient has requested that we delay the scholarship until the winter. Paul motioned and Erin seconded. Motion passed.
