

**SOUTH LYON PANTHERS – Livingston County Area Junior Football League**  
**Meeting Minutes for June 13<sup>th</sup>, 2011 - 7:00 pm at Millennium Middle School – Room 132**

**Call To Order – 7:04 PM**

**Attendance** – The President being in the chair and the Secretary being present. All others being present.

**Review of Minutes** – The May 2011 meeting minutes were read to the public and approved.

- Jen is still waiting on sizes from a few girls and w/like everything done by the end of June. Teresa G. has a few girls who need to join late – we will allow them to register by the end of this week, Friday June 17<sup>th</sup>.

- Kevin will need to supply our 501 information asap for our possible grant.
