MEETING MINUTES

June 5, 2006

Call to order at 7:37 PM.

Not in attendance – Equipment Manager Caltrider & Volunteer Manager Burnette

President Camacho read meeting minutes from May 2006.

****MOTION**** by Registration Secretary Camacho seconded by Vice President Dillon – Approval of May 2006 meeting minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Call to Public – Bruce Green questioned how to sponsor advertisement. He was told that the South Lyon Panthers do not own signs, but also told him about the yearbook and festival advertisements upcoming this year.

Permanent Committee Reports

Football (Commissioner Caltrider)

Fenton has officially resigned from the LCAJFL. The LCAJFL will be releasing a tentative schedule soon.

Mandatory head coaches meeting – July 12th @ Brighton High School.

Alternate dates for the coaches meeting are July 11th and July 27th (in Howell). All head coaches must attend. LCAJFL is trying to get all teams to flow into 14 kids per age group. South Lyon sets its rosters up each year with the intent on having 14 players per team per age group.

Brighton has officially elected a new board of directors.

Hartland has an autistic player who was moved to Jr. Conference team.

Howell had extra players on JV waitlist in which they offered varsity positions to 12 yr. old players.

We will have 4 divisions, and 2 Jr. Conference divisions this year. Jr. Conference will most likely have one bye week.

Motion did not carry. We will utilize the normal block numbers seen on all other Panther jerseys. The white uniform will consist of a white jersey with blue numbers and blue pants.

****MOTION**** by Registration Secretary Camacho seconded by Vice President Dillon – Replace this spot with a player from the wait list. Motion carried.

Cheer/Pom (Vice President Dillon)

Brighton commissioners were at meeting asking for help this year. We told all communities that they would get festival packet at the June meeting. All forms need to be back by the August meeting.

Treasury (Treasurer Harper)

Financial statement submitted and approved.

We had four checks that bounced. Two families have made good, the other two have not (1 cheer/ 1 JV gold football). Treasurer Harper has contacted these families on multiple occasions.

Ordered 32 new shells. 11- blue/gold, 21- black/silver. Order should be in by the end of August.

Currently looking for a large facility to host scrap booking event in November.
Need number of players to be able to order raffle tickets.

Volunteer (Volunteer Manager Burnette)

Sign up sheets were brought to cheer/pom equipment try-on.
